Vocabulary	anticipate - When you <i>anticipate</i> something like a party, you look forward to it.	demolish – to <i>demolish</i> something is to destroy or break it.
	realize - When you understand something you’ve seen, read, or heard, you <i>realize</i> it.	repair -when you <i>repair</i> something, you fix it.
	favorite - Something that you like the most, such as a movie or a song, is your <i>favorite</i> .	alert - To be alert is to be very cautious of situations that may be dangerous.
	surface - The <i>surface</i> is the top layer of something, such as the top layer of the earth.	earthquake - an <i>earthquake</i> is a natural disaster that causes the ground to shake.
	volcano - A <i>volcano</i> is an opening in the earth’s crust through which hot rock, steam, or ashes reach the surface and eventually form its cone-like shape.	landslide - A <i>landslide</i> occurs when a section of land from a higher area, such as the top of a hill, breaks away and tumbles to a lower area.
