On August 28, 1963, thousands of people gathered peacfully and lawfuly in Washington,

D.C. to support civil rights. This important event was called *The March on Washington for Jobs*and Freedom. During this time, there was an important bill in Congress than many sincirely hoped would be passed into law.

Philip Randolph started the idea for the 1963
march. He asked an experienced organizer, Bayard
Rustin, to help him. These two men, and many others,
began to bussily prepare for the demonstration. Many
