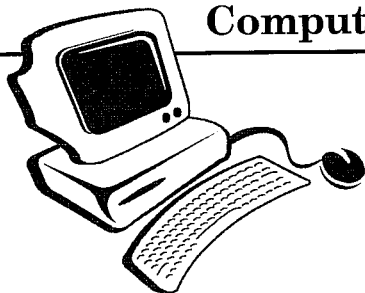

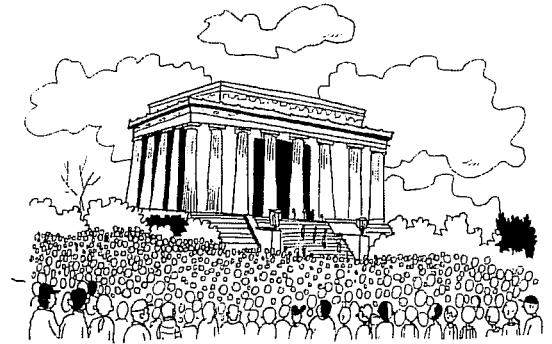

On August 28, 1963, thousands of people gathered peacefully and lawfully in Washington, D.C. to support civil rights. This important event was called *The March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom*. During this time, there was an important bill in Congress than many sincerely hoped would be passed into law.

Philip Randolph started the idea for the 1963 march. He asked an experienced organizer, Bayard Rustin, to help him. These two men, and many others, began to bussily prepare for the demonstration. Many



people were fearful that the march would get out of control. The Washington police and the march organizers worked directly with each other to carfully plan a peaceful event.

Many great leaders gave speeches about freedom and equal rights for everyone. Martin Luther King, Jr. gave his famous speech, *I Have a Dream*. Marchers held up signs that they had colorfuley painted. Thinkfully, the day went smothlly, and was an enormous success.

On July 2, 1964, the Civil Right Act of 1964 was passed by Congress. The March on Washington is considered a major event that helped make this happen.
