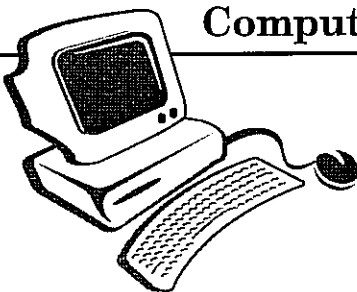

"No, I mean the tree has gotten taller," said the first toad.

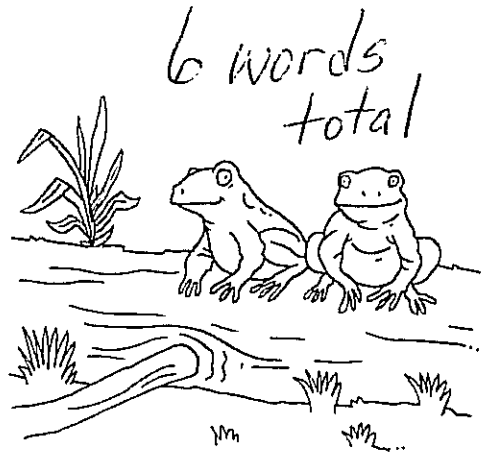
The two toads sat in silence for a minute and watched the sunrise. Then the first toad said, "The morne is a good time to sit quietly and think."
