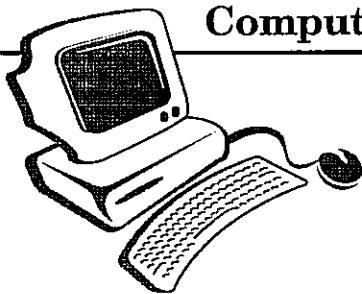

Dear Faimly,

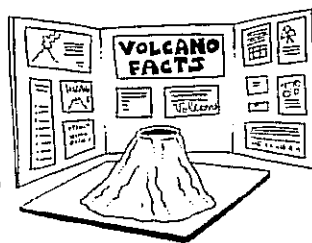
